

## **TDC Safety Procedures:**

1. TDC is cleaned daily and is also frequently sprayed down by Ecovasive, a cleaning company that sprays the entire studio with a non-toxic layer of antimicrobial spray that lasts for 30-90 days. All cleaning products are FDA and CDC approved.
2. Please make sure you can answer “**no**” to all of our pre-screening health questions (see below).
3. **Masks are required** when entering studio. Only dancers should enter unless prior arrangements were made for parent/guardian to enter for payment, etc. (Preschool and Combo dance parents may have 1 representative for first and last 5 minutes of class as needed.) The lobby will be closed until further notice.
4. Temperature checks will be taken upon entry. Temperatures greater than 99.5 degrees will be sent home.
5. Please use hand sanitizer and hold onto dance bag upon entering your specific dance room (please keep bags with you and use cubbies in studios while in class.) Backpacks may be stored in break room.
6. Once inside your first dance room, you may remove mask if desired when starting to dance. Please keep mask in your own dance bag while dancing. (Masks are encouraged to be worn in class but not required.)
7. When you leave dance room for any reason (restroom, water, or to change classes) please put mask back on. Repeat for each class. Please wash hands or use hand sanitizer between each class.
8. Each class will be released 5-10 minutes early so that instructor may properly disinfect before the next class enters. Each room has its own box of cleaning supplies.
9. While in dance rooms, dancers must stay on their assigned mark on the floor that has been measured for distance between dancers.
10. Please make sure to put on mask while waiting for your transportation.
11. The water fountain will be closed until further notice. We will have bottled water for sale in case anyone forgets his or her water bottle, but bringing own is encouraged.
12. Please make sure that dancers are dropped off no more than 5 minutes prior to class time and picked up on time.
13. In the event that a dancer has a break between classes, the break room will NOT be open at this time. Dancers should be picked up between classes OR utilize outdoor tables that will be set up on the south end of the courtyard. If dancers leave the building, they must notify Miss Jen at the front office. Eating may only occur outside.
14. If anyone is feeling ill, PLEASE do not come to the studio!
15. In the event that a dancer or instructor tests Covid positive, the St. Johns County Health Department will be notified for proper steps. If necessary, a class will have to learn virtually until dancers are cleared to return. Every situation will be explained to Health Department to ensure proper protocol, and the appropriate notifications will take place.
16. Parents~ please remind your dancers, especially young dancers, about the importance of keeping hands to self and following directions. We will unfortunately have to have dancers picked up if they are not able to follow directions. Thank you for your patience and understanding!

## **TDC COVID 19 Screening Questionnaire**

(To be completed by all teachers, staff, dancers, and visitors.)

1. Have you been in direct contact with someone with a confirmed case of coronavirus (COVID-19)?
2. Have you traveled outside of the country in the last 14 days?
3. Have you been in contact with someone who has traveled outside of the country in the last 14 days who is now ill?
4. Have you been in contact with a person with confirmed or under investigation for coronavirus (COVID-19) within the last 14 days?
5. Have you exhibited shortness of breath, sore throat, fever, cough, rash, OR a combination of 2 of any of the following symptoms: diarrhea, chills, shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, acute loss of taste or smell?

\*Those who answer YES to any of the above will not be allowed to attend class/work and will require a note from physician and/or Negative test results in order to return.
